ii) Deputy Mayor Tyrone Raddi raised the following statement/ concern/suggestion:

Comment for future fundraising, do homework before. Due to excess transactions my bank account is flagged and branch is in south and i cannot go to the branch.

Mayor responded with it was identified beforehand but do not know if bank was notified and will do follow up with SAO. In the future, try and prevent.

Tyrone-in the future, before doing fundraising, send official letter to bank stating that this is legitimate for fundraising.

Comment Ikalualuq enjoyed jamboree/could be improvements to track? /suggest that to committee.

Comment Ikalualuq also commented that the location of the Lighthouse/Glad Tidings Church was dangerous to ongoing traffic because of children, hazardous to drivers because of vehicles parked around that area. They should not be putting anyone at risk.

Should we ban them if they do not comply with suggestion to sell at the jamboree site or should they be forced to share food? By selling at the church they are keeping people from the site and jamborees are meant for people to be mingling/visiting with each other. Maybe 2 solutions are to ban them or sell at the site because they do take away from the jamboree.

Also people selling from home took away from jamboree by selling from home.

Another concern was there was so much garbage left by the pit crews of the racer/area. This is not good for environment, should we get volunteers/committee to clean up? If we can bark at companies to clean after themselves, shouldn't we bark at the local people too?

The mayor responded with at the past music fest we had garbage bins, also should put some at site. Will get them to clean up before too late.

Comment Ikalualuq Every year the snow get plowed to the lakes/ocean/harbour and garbage is also built up in this snow which pollutes our own waters Should follow Inuvik and get pushed to certain area let it melt and pick up garbage from there after it melts.

Mayor responded that he will check with foreman and see if we can fit in his budget to do so.
