i) Councillor Tianna Gordon-Ruben made the following concern/suggestion:

- She stated that she's concerned with the amount of drinking going on in town and that hopefully we get activities done. She stated that she's looking forward to the prohibition.

ii) Councillor Joe Nasogaluak made the following concern/suggestion:

- He stated that the energy drinks being sold at the stores you see young kids going out of the store with them. He stated that we should let the community know and write a letter to the 3 stores to make sure they are selling to the legal age of sale.
- He stated that on the point where the high water mark is there should be a sign for the dangers.

Mayor Erwin Elias stated that we did put barricades there but maybe we have to use big red signs that state this is a cultural use area.

Councillor Tyrone Raddi stated that we should put an extreme cut bank sign there by the Trans Canada Trail sign to the point.

Mayor Erwin Elias stated that educating the community through the radio station.

iii) Councillor Ikalualuq made the following concern/suggestion:

- He stated that COVID-19 is spreading in the communities. People with chronic illnesses they would like to know if we can get booster shots.

SAO Shawn Stuckey advised Council to contact the nurse in charge at the health centre.

- He stated that it should be posted in the community that the Hamlet made the decision to be proactive with the Northern and Stanton's store.

iv) Councillor Ryan Yakeleya made the following concern/suggestion:

- He stated that with COVID-19 all the restrictions are coming again. He stated that it's a good wakeup call for people that never got their shots.

Mayor Erwin Elias would like to know what the actual percentage is in the community.

Shawn Lundrigan stated that in the south you see them opening up more to those who are vaccinated as they have more privileges.

v) Councillor Shawn Lundrigan made the following concern/suggestion:

- He stated that its good to see the drum packer put on the road. He stated that this might be on the Foreman's wish list.
- He commended the Public Works crew for the work done on the roads.
- He informed Council that the pricing for a speed limit sign would cost roughly around \$1100.00.

Mayor Erwin Elias directed Councillor Lundrigan to send the information to administration.

- He informed Council that the Canadian Coast Guard will be doing work in Tuk. He stated that he emailed the ASAO as he couldn't email the SAO. He suggested that the SAO attend this.

- He questioned the MTS land and if the Hamlet ever pursued this option.

SAO Shawn Stuckey advised Council that there are 4 lots there and the other 2 lots need to be surveyed.

- He stated that in the MTS yard there is a container that has the curling rink shell. He'd like to see this moved onto Hamlet property.
- He stated that it's important sometimes we don't benefit ourselves by giving ourselves a pat on the back. He stated that our Council has been good and active. He stated that we all have a strong passion for the community and we work together. He stated that we see arguments and good debates and at the end of the day everybody is here for the community.
- He commended the Assistant Senior Administrative Officer and the Senior Administrative Officer for the big projects they've got for us as these applications are big. He stated that there is a small group that has tremendous amount of work. He stated that overall we need to commend our staff and us also.
