b) Kearney Coupland

Ms. Coupland thanked Mayor and Council for providing her the time to provide an update regarding the planned retreat/relocation planning project and the steps needed to move forward.

She informed Council that she received \$386K to support a Community Relocation Planning Coordinator through the Climate Change Preparedness in the North (CCPN) funding. She noted that this position would be for a one-year term with the possibility of extension. She is requesting approval from Council to post the position.

She also spoke on the creation of a Community Relocation Planning Committee that would consist of two elders, two youth ages (18-25) and two adults (26-40) and additionally two individuals in community leadership roles.

She also noted that there is funding to have one representative from the Hamlet attend a four day workshop in Anchorage, Alaska.

Morgen Bertheussen, Researcher at McGill University has been working with Ms. Coupland and the NUNA team for the last 4 years as well and is in charge of developing a community survey that is focused on the relocation project. She provided copies to Council to review and hand back prior to Spring so that the survey can be rolled out as soon as possible.

Councillors Audrey Nasogaluak, Elizabeth Arey and Youth Representative Miley Wolki joined the meeting at 4:25pm

Mayor Erwin Elias stated that we are in the early stages of this relocation project and that the coordinator hired would gather all the information for us. He noted that we need to be broadcasting what is being done in regard to this project so that residents are informed. He thanked the team for coming down and presenting Council with the information and acknowledged Devalynn Pokiak for all the work she has been doing for NUNA since she started.
